Mission Gallery is proud of its rich and layered history and this summer's exhibition will provide a glimpse of the stories, memories and highlights, with texts by writer and curator Sally Moss, events, activities and workshops.

For this 40th Anniversary exhibition, our current and past Staff, Volunteers and Board of Directors will be selecting their favourite Artists and Makers from the last four decades. Contributions and donations via artwork, workshops, writing, poetry and music as well as comments and congratulations from those who have been involved, supported, enjoyed and loved Mission Gallery, will all be part of a summer of celebration and activity. Look out for our digital exhibition catalogue with text by writer and curator Sally Moss, themed workshops and also ways to donate and support Mission Gallery and its future forty years.

This will be part of the launch of Swansea Fringe Festival which returns this year and kicks off the first weekend of Swansea International Festival on the 29th and 30th September.

Mission Gallery is delighted to present the work of Brooklyn based artist Doug Ashford in his first solo exhibition in Wales, delivered in partnership with Swansea International Festival.

This new video animation *Bunker 2*, intersperses news clippings dated from 1982 to 2016 with bands of changing colour. The barrage of images and the black metal that accompanies them, presents an overwhelming concurrence of fact and feeling. As images blend into one another, and the aesthetic connection to colour allows intuition to take over, the work suggest the possibility that our emotions can resist the culture of publicity and reshape notions of progress.

Bunker 2 was first shown in May 2017 at MASS MoCA's *In the Abstract* exhibition, which brought together a diverse, multi-generational group of artists whose works represented a potent and muscular approach to contemporary abstraction. Doug Ashford is an artist, teacher and writer based in New York. He is Associate Professor at The Cooper Union where he has taught sculpture, design, and interdisciplinary studies since 1989. He is represented by Wilfried Lentz, Rotterdam.



Isabelle Gressell

9 SEPT - 15 OCT 2017

Scale of movements is a specially created video work for Mission Gallery celebrating urban movements. Pigeons pecking, store signs tapping, cars hurtling, bins rattling, clothes flapping, leaves rustling: cities are in a state of perpetual motion. Inside our homes we mirror these movements: swirling teaspoons, crunching teeth, padding footsteps. Even in the dead of night nothing is still, a plastic bag rustles and an eyelid flickers. Through an extensive collected archive of motion within our cities, Gressel has choreographed the mundane, often overlooked everyday movements, inviting the viewer to reflect on their urban landscape.



KESS II PhD

Over the next three years Mission Gallery is pleased to be supporting - both financially and professionally - artist Jason Cartwright's KESS II funded PhD research at Swansea College of Art, University of Wales Trinity St. David. This innovative, exciting partnership between the artist and Mission Gallery, as industry partner, is complemented by Becky Williams' related research. Becky is Jason's long time collaborator, who is herself undertaking KESS funded PhD research supported by the Coastal Housing Group.

These partnerships will enable collaborative duo Jason&Becky to work alongside staff at Mission Gallery and Coastal Housing to examine how their practice engages with communities outside the gallery space and the effect this may have on the wellbeing of participants. The current theoretical frameworks being explored by both artists are revealing some significant and exciting gaps in knowledge in this area, and this will inform the practice-based elements of their research.

This research comes at a pertinent time in Wales as the Wellbeing of Future Generations Act increases awareness of the role of art-based institutions in the ongoing wellbeing of communities, and is testament to the ambitions of Mission Gallery to be at the forefront of methodologies that engage visitors beyond the gallery walls.

Mission Gallery is one of Wales' most inspirational spaces for the contemporary arts. Mission Gallery has developed a reputation for dynamic and distinctive programming, to present excellence across the visual arts, applied arts and craft, from across Wales and beyond.

We are located on Swansea Marina near the City Centre, a 15 minute walk from Swansea Train Station and a 10 minute walk from Swansea's central bus station. Pay & display car parks are situated close by, with limited free 3 hour parking outside the gallery. Access is by one-step entry from pavement level through to our main entrance.
