### Do you know a talented young person who loves drawing, making, building and creating?

*Criw Celf Primary* is an Arts Council of Wales funded project for children who have shown a talent or special interest in Art. Young people from the Swansea and Neath Port Talbot areas, in Years 5 & 6 can apply and become part of this exciting creative project at Mission Gallery.

Over several weeks, taking place on Saturdays, participants will have the opportunity to enjoy **five master classes** led by professional artists and designers, exploring a range of art techniques and skills. This is an amazing opportunity to be part of a regular art club, make new friends with similar interests and learn new skills.

### Information for Teachers and Parents

#### Who are we looking for?

Young people in Years 5 or 6 (aged 9 to 11) at Primary level who are 'More Able and Talented' in Art - those children who are creative, imaginative and enthusiastic about the subject. They may love drawing, painting, making or building, they may spend their time inventing characters, making animations or taking photographs. These are the artistic individuals we would love to see apply for our *Criw Celf Primary* programme.

#### What does the programme include?

*Five master class workshops in a variety of Art and Design areas*

*The opportunity to experience working alongside professional Artists and Designers*

*A study visit to an exhibition or museum (Such as Cardiff or Bristol)*

*A professional group exhibition showcasing the work that has been created during Criw Celf master classes.*

*An Art Materials Kit and certificate of their achievement upon completion of the programme.*

Each school can nominate up to 10 students who demonstrate exceptional ability in the field of art, craft or design. Teachers may send this as one large application.

### Two Self Portraits

Two self-portraits in colour. Interpret this task any way you want- they can be as expressive, colourful or abstract as you like. Maybe this portrait can tell us more about you than just a drawing of your face?

### Two pieces of Creative Work

We will also accept any other work that you have completed recently. Perhaps an interesting photograph you have taken, painting, sculpture or animation. We would love to see them!

AND

A short statement telling us why you wish to join *Criw Celf Primary* (No more than 50 words)

Please include the applicants contact details; name, age, address, email and telephone number. Plus the school they attend and art teacher.
