Criw Celf Secondary is an Arts Council of Wales funded project for children who have shown a talent or special interest in Art. Young people from schools in Swansea and Neath Port Talbot, in Years 7 & 8, are able to apply and become part of this exciting project at Mission Gallery.

Over several weeks, taking place on Saturdays, participants will have the opportunity to enjoy **five master classes** led by professional artists and designers, exploring a range of art techniques and skills. This is an amazing opportunity to take part in regular art workshops, build on your creativity and have your work exhibited in a public space.

Who are we looking for?

Young people in Years 7 or 8 (aged 11 to 13) at Secondary level who are 'More Able and Talented' in Art - those children who are creative, imaginative and enthusiastic about the subject. They may love drawing, painting, making or building, they may spend their time inventing characters, making animations or taking photographs. These are the artistic individuals we would love to see apply for our *Criw Celf Secondary* programme.

What does the programme include?

Five master class workshops in a variety of Art and Design areas

The opportunity to experience working alongside professional Artists and Designers

A study visit to an exhibition or museum (Such as Cardiff or Bristol)

A professional group exhibition showcasing the work that has been created during Criw Celf master classes.

An Art Materials Kit and certificate of their achievement upon completion of the programme.

Each school can nominate up to 10 students who demonstrate exceptional ability in the field of art, craft or design. Teachers may send this as one large application.

To apply each applicant will need to send us

Two pieces of Creative Work

It is important that these pieces reflect something about who you are and your interests. They could be self portraits, abstract paintings, interesting photographs you have taken, drawings, sculptures or animations. We would love to see them!

AND

A short statement telling us why you wish to join Criw Celf Secondary (No more than 50 words)

Please include the applicants contact details; name, age, address, email and telephone number. Plus the school they attend and art teacher.
