Who are we looking for?

They may love drawing, painting, making or building, they may spend their time inventing characters, making animations or taking photographs. These are the artistic individuals we would love to see apply for our *Criw Celf Secondary* programme.

What does the programme include?

Master class workshops in a variety of Art and Design areas, taking place over weekends in Summer

The opportunity to experience working alongside professional Artists and Designers

A professional group exhibition showcasing the work that has been created during Criw Celf master classes.

An Art Materials Kit and certificate of their achievement upon completion of the programme.

Each school can nominate students who demonstrate exceptional ability in the field of art, craft or design. Teachers may send this as one large application.
