



from your favourite story

After you read the story, make a list of the characters.


In my case, the characters are:

- -The Princess
- -The Frog Prince (as a frog & as a human)
- -The King
- -8 horses
- -Heinrich the servant



Now choose the character you want to create!

I will choose the Frog Prince, in his frog shape.



Make a list of the essential features of the character.


In my case, I will write down:

- -He is a water frog (green colour)
- -He can talk
- -He is demanding
- -He is an enchanted prince




Ask yourself!

Which features can be presented visually? (without talking, listening or acting)
I believe I can represent the colour and I can also saw the frog was a prince by adding a little crown on top of the frog's head.




Start creating!

Now that I know what I want to make, I will start creating my Frog Prince!



I will need:


- -1 toilet roll cardboard
- -Glue (any type you like)
- -Green, yellow & white card / sheet (or can improvise!)
- -A pencil
- -A black marker
- -Scissors
- -A ruler



Cut, fit and glue...

...a piece of green sheet around the toilet roll cardboard.


This will be the body!



Draw a circle...

...on the green sheet and cut around it.

This will be the head!



Draw two smaller circles...


...on the white sheet and cut around them.

These will be the frog's eyes!




Glue...

...the two eyes on top of the head.




If you want...

...you can use your black marker to draw a smile on the face.



Glue

...the head on top of the body.




On the green sheet...

...draw and cut the two front legs.




Glue...

...the legs on the body.




On the green sheet...

...draw and cut the two back legs.



Glue...


...the back legs on the sides of the body.



What is missing now...


...is the little crown!

Draw the shape on the yellow sheet. Cut around it and glue it on the frog's head.



Use the black marker...

...and draw a set of eyes. If you have a set of googly eyes, feel free to use them!
